NOTICE TO CONTESTANTS

1. **LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS:**

The SCGA Golf Course  
39500 Robert Trent Jones Parkway  
Murrieta, CA 92563

From the North: I-15 or I-215 to Murrieta Hot Springs Rd.; exit east to Winchester Rd.; north to Robert Trent Jones Parkway; west to clubhouse.  
From the South: I-15 to Winchester Rd. going east; north to Robert Trent Jones Parkway; west to clubhouse

Parking will be available for all participants, coaches and spectators in the main parking lot.

2. **REGISTRATION:**

Registration begins at 6:30 a.m. near the circle drive bag drop area. Coaches are responsible for registering their teams / players. A high school coach or authorized school representative must accompany each player and will be the only person allowed to sign in. Coaches will receive packets (including a copy of the USGA Rules of Golf in Brief, hole location sheet, bag tag, scorecard and lunch ticket) to distribute to their team members.

3. **STARTING TIMES AND PAIRINGS:**

There will be a shotgun start beginning at 8:00 a.m. The field will be comprised of up to 124 players arranged in groups of 3-4.

Players must report to the circle drive bag drop area no later than 7:45 a.m. and will be provided with transportation to their respective starting tee.

Pairings will be posted on the WSCGA web site ([www.womensgolf.org](http://www.womensgolf.org)) on Friday, November 13th and available at the course on the morning of the event.

4. **FORMAT:**

**Individual Competition:**

Any player who has qualified for the individual or team competition is eligible to compete in this category.

All participants in the individual competition will play 18 holes of stroke play. The WSCGA Combo tee markers (yardage 5713; 75.5/137) will be used for the Championship.

The top six individuals will receive WSCGA Foundation medallions for the individual competition. Ties for first place will be decided by a sudden-death playoff beginning on hole #1 immediately after the conclusion of play. Subsequent ties will be decided by matching scorecards using the USGA recommended tie-breaking procedure. Ties for 6th place will receive duplicate medallions.

The top six individual competitors, not on any of the top three teams, will advance to the CIF State Championship at Poppy Hills in Pebble Beach on November 19, 2009. Ties within the top five will be decided by matching scorecards using the USGA recommended tie-breaking procedure for ranking purposes only. Ties for the sixth qualifying spot will be decided by a sudden-death playoff beginning immediately after the conclusion of play starting on hole #1 or #10 at the discretion of the WSCGA Foundation Tournament Committee.

**Team Competition:**

In addition to the individual competition, there will also be a team competition. Teams will consist of six players. The best five of the six players' scores will be used to determine the team champion, runner-up and third place. Ties for the top three places in the team competition will be decided by adding the sixth player's score to the team total. If still tied, the USGA tie-breaking procedure will be utilized using the total scores of all six players on each team for holes 10-18, if still tied holes 13-18, if still tied holes 16-18, if still tied hole 18.

The top three teams will advance to the CIF State Championship.

5. **RULES:**  
The USGA Rules of Golf govern all play. Any Local Rules which apply during the tournament will be distributed to participants at registration. Questions will be referred to the WSCGA Foundation Tournament Committee whose decisions(s) shall be final.

**GPS Devices:** All electronic distance measuring devices are prohibited per CIF Rules.

**Advice:**

Participants are reminded of USGA Rule of Golf #8 (Advice and Assistance) which specifically prohibits players from receiving any counsel or suggestion from anyone (including parents, coaches, other players or spectators) that could influence them in determining their play, the choice of club or the method of making a stroke.

**Note:** Information on the Rules of Golf and Local Rules for this competition is not considered advice.

6. **DRESS CODE FOR PLAYERS / SPECTATORS:**

**Women:** Collared shirts, slacks, skorts, skirts or hemmed shorts no more than 3" above the knee are permitted. Blue jeans (including any designer jeans), T-shirts, tank tops and cargo shorts are prohibited.

**Men:** Collared shirts are required. Hemmed shorts may be worn but must be no more than 3" above the knee. Blue jeans (including any designer jeans), T-shirts, tank tops and cargo shorts are prohibited.

**Gallery:** Same as players

**Shirts must be tucked in and hat bills are to worn forward.**

**Footwear:** Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e. ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION**

**The Dress Code will be strictly enforced.**

7. **LOCKER ROOM:**

A locker room will not be available for this competition.

8. **FOOD:**

A Continental breakfast and box lunch (tickets provided in registration packets) will be hosted by the WSCGA Foundation for all players, one coach per team / individual, and WSCGA Tournament Officials.

The Snack Bar at the course will be open to spectators and parents for the purchase of food.

9. **DRIVING RANGE:**

The driving range will be open Monday, November 16 at 6:30 a.m. Practice balls will be at the range and will be hosted by the WSCGA Foundation.

10. **PRACTICE ROUNDS:**

Practice rounds will be permitted with no restrictions. Players and/or coaches are responsible for arrangements with the Pro Shop (800-752-9724) and all associated costs.

**Note:** It will be permissible for players and coaches to walk the course on the day of the tournament in accordance with CIF guidelines. All such players and coaches must stay on the cart path and be off the course no later than 8:00 a.m. **Players may not have in their possession golf balls or clubs of any kind during the walk around. A coach or school official must accompany all players.**

11. **ELECTRIC GOLF CARTS AND CADDIES:**

Each player must carry her own clubs. Manual push/pull carts will be permitted. A player must provide her own push/pull cart. There will be no rentals available at the course on the day of the tournament.

Caddies and electric carts and/or electric push/pull carts are not permitted.

**Note:** Coaches, parents, media and/or spectators may not use golf carts at any time. **No exceptions.**

12. **CELL PHONES AND COMMUNICATION DEVICES:**

No cell phones, walkie-talkies or other communication devices will be allowed by anyone on the golf course with the exception of the WSCGA Foundation Tournament Committee and golf course personnel.

13. **GALLERY AND MEDIA:**

Gallery and media are encouraged to attend; however all spectators and media must remain at a distance of 30 yards from players at all times and are not permitted to walk on the fairways.

14. **AWARDS:**

Awards will be sponsored by the WSCGA Foundation in the following categories:

**Individual Awards:**

Champion	Medallion with diamond
Runner-up	Medallion with precious stone
Third Place	Medallion with precious stone
Fourth Place	Medallion with precious stone
Fifth Place	Medallion with precious stone
Sixth Place	Medallion with no stone
Sixth Place Ties	Medallion with no stone

The six individual qualifiers for the State Championship will receive medals from CIF

**Team Awards:**

Champion	Perpetual Team trophy and gold pins to team members and coach
Runner-up	Silver pins to team members and coach
Third Place	White pins to team members and coach

15. **SIZE OF FIELD:**

Central Section:	Up to 12 individuals	Two 6-person teams	= 24
LA City Section	Up to 12 individuals	Two 6-person teams	= 24
San Diego Section	Up to 12 individuals	Two 6-person teams	= 24
Southern Sections	Up to 28 individuals	Four 6-person teams	= 52

16. **NOTIFICATION OF QUALIFIERS:**

Section officials are responsible for distributing the "Notice to Contestants" to all eligible participants.

Commissioners from each CIF Section are to notify the WSCGA office regarding the players who have qualified for the championship. Information for both the individual qualifiers and team members shall include the players name, school, city, WSCGA # (if known) and qualifying score (for pairing purposes). Please spell names correctly as the information provided will be used for scoreboards and scorecards.

Each CIF Commissioner is to fax or email their typed results to the WSCGA office as soon as possible following the conclusion of Sectional qualifying and **no later than 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 11**. (If Sectional qualifying concludes after that date, please send results as soon as they are available).

Each CIF Section is responsible for designating alternates in the event of cancellations. A vacancy may be filled by the next qualified alternate from the particular Section involved and upon authorization from the CIF Section Commissioner. Use of alternates on the day of the championship will not be permitted. Section Commissioners making changes **must** call Sheri Ross at (949) 933-5228.

**Alternate positions may only be finalized by your Section Commissioner. Do not call the WSCGA.**

**Note:** An alternate will be paired in the same position as the player she has replaced.
